

# Gabon: Inauguration of the Libreville airport bypass

Libreville, Sunday, September 1, 2024 (Infos Gabon) – This 2x3 lane and 2x2 lane road, inaugurated on August 29 by General Brice Clotaire Oligui Nguema, will help relieve traffic congestion in the northern area of Libreville.

Urban mobility is now reassured on the Libreville – Akanda axis via Alibandeng and Okala. Motorists and other users can now travel in the light on a safe road without fearing any danger as before.

And for good reason, the airport bypass was inaugurated by the President of the Transition, General Brice Clotaire Oligui Nguema, during a ceremony that took place in the presence of members of the Transitional government and the CTRI.

This opening thus puts an end to the ordeal of the populations and road users who were confronted with traffic jams to reach the north of Libreville.

This section will make it possible to smooth traffic and considerably reduce the travel time between the commune of Akanda and the rest of Greater Libreville.

The result of a partnership between the company Arise, GSEZ Airport and the Gabonese State, the work on this road, approximately 5.7 km long, was carried out in quality and sustainability by the company AFCONS. To carry out this work, 2 hectares of mangrove were destroyed by workers who confronted the swamps.

Well before the start of the work, modern houses were built on another site with land titles for the benefit of the people impacted by this project, the completion of which brought joy to local residents and the entire community. The latter even expressed the wish to see other similar projects materialize with a view to improving living conditions in Greater Libreville.
